- Solutions Team, Miles
 - 2022- served over 102 clients, 90% referrals from website and school counselors/fam support workers, 10% referrals from Unite Us, our platform
 - 80-90% household goods, housing, utilities
 - Few cases, niche resources- limbo health insurance- recently helped with eye glass eval/glasses
 - Another example, provided space heaters until heating fixed, will donate them back to Families in Crisis after home fixed
- Finance Update, Angie
 - We spent \$7942 with solutions team last year
 - Much of it was Utilities, moving storage, lodging/rental assistance
 - Budget: Total income last year: \$31632 and expenses: \$17,071
